HOW IT WORKS

Share your story

During your first call, we ask a few get-to-know-you questions about what you've been going through. These details help us understand and address your unique needs.

Find local services

We'll then search our statewide database to find the best referral(s) you may be eligible for and that best serve your healing and recovery.

Get help for other areas of your life

Receive referrals for public programs, social services, and resources for other important needs such as housing, food, employment, and transportation.

Receive ongoing support

In some cases, with consent, Care Coordinators will follow up with a treatment provider, the judiciary (probation/parole), or other case managers to coordinate SUD services and care.
